ATLANTIC CANADA SOLAR SUMMIT 2022 | HALIFAX, NS — DECEMBER 7, 2022

Have you or your organization developed an innovative approach or a practical solution or product that advances solar technology or accelerates adoption of solar? Here's your chance to showcase your work!

The Atlantic Canada Solar Summit (ACSS) 2022 organizing committee is looking for project profiles, product demonstrations, and solar best practices that advance our understanding of technology and promotes and facilitates the adoption of solar energy.

## THE OPPORTUNITY:

Building on the success of the 2018 and 2019 Nova Scotia Solar Summits, and after a two-year break during the pandemic, the 2022 summit will expand to include the other Atlantic provinces and address the growing interest in solar energy around the region.

ACSS will include presentations on relevant solar topics and existing solar policies and programs. The Summit will also provide opportunities to network and share experiences and will include an inspiring conference keynote, breakout sessions and an exhibitor tradeshow to showcase the region's growing solar industry.

ACSS has limited opportunities for presentations as part of the conference program in Halifax on December 7, 2022

- Breakout presentations of 60 minutes.
- Depending on the abstracts received the ASCC committee may bundle presentations into a panel presentation.
- You may submit as many abstracts as you wish
- Selected speakers will receive one complimentary summit registration and one complimentary admission to the post event Solar Mixer

## THE REQUIREMENTS:

Submit by e-mail a 300-400 word abstract that:

- describes the presentation topic
  - identifies your willingness to work with other presenters
  - identifies the speaker(s),
  - offers links to online audio/video of the presenter, if available.
  - Identifies other groups that you've previously presented to.
- Submit a 150-word profile or bio of each presenter with your abstract, demonstrating each speaker's depth of professional experience.
  - Presentations must limit corporate messages and references. **This is not a sales pitch!**
  - Successful presenters must provide either proof of ownership of all images, or permission to use the images, in their presentations.
  - CEU's that your presentation is approved for if any.
  - Final presentations must be submitted in electronic format no later than two weeks prior to the conference dates.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- Selections will be determined by the ACSS 2022 organizing committee.
- Electronic presentations will on the Solar Nova Scotia website after the event.
- Preference will be given to Solar Nova Scotia Members. Make sure your membership is up-to-date. ■
